SUNDAY MORNINGS

9 & 10:45am, Arden Hills & Roseville

NURSERY (Birth–Age 2)

Young children receive loving, gentle care in a safe, well-staffed environment while their families attend worship services. Mornings often include simple Bible teachings, prayer, and learning activities as children are ready.

TREEHOUSE SUNDAY SCHOOL

(Age 2–Grade 5 as of Sep. 1)

Children enjoy being a part of a large group experience where they can worship and learn about the special plans God has for them as revealed in his Word. Our leaders and Treehouse characters bring Bible stories and teachings to life in ways that children can relate to and understand.

Another valuable component of Sunday morning for children is small group time where they build relationships with their leaders and other children their age. Here they share and pray with others, and apply biblical truths to their lives through a variety of fun, meaningful, and creative activities.

SPECIAL NEEDS

We welcome all children and want to provide assistance for children who may have special needs in adapting to our ministries. Trained coaches are matched with children (contingent upon volunteers) through our Children’s Special Needs Ministry. A specialized class is offered during the 10:45am hour at the Arden Hills campus.

WEDNESDAY EVENINGS

7–8:30pm, Arden Hills

KINGDOM KIDS (Age 4–Grade 5 as of Sep. 1)

A fun-filled kids’ club that incorporates active learning through Bible memory activities, gym games, teachings on character, crafts, life-skill lessons, worship, and earning badges. It’s a great way for kids to make new friends.

Kids in this program also have the opportunity to be a part of many exciting and varied events like the overnight, pinewood derby, sailboat regatta, and family events.

Nursery is available Wednesday evenings for volunteers with children under 4 years old.

BIBLE MEMORIZATION (VERSES FOR LIFE)

Hiding God’s Word in the hearts of children is very important. It will provide them with hope and direction all of their lives. To encourage memorization, we select “life verses” and plan special events and Sundays filled with a variety of activities to encourage memorization.

TOGETHER IN FAITH

Classes for parents and children to build the necessary foundations of faith in a child’s life. Classes are offered Sunday mornings and are each 2–3 sessions.
